

Facing Trouble Playing iPhone Videos on Your Laptop?

No worries! If you're using a Windows or Linux laptop and can't open videos recorded on your rented iPhone, this quick guide will help you fix the issue using VLC Media Player.

Why This Happens:

iPhones record videos in the **.MOV** format using the **HEVC** (**H.265**) codec. Some laptops don't support this format natively—especially older systems or ones without codec packs.

The Easy Fix: Re-encode the Video with VLC Media Player

Follow these simple steps:

- Open VLC Media Player
 (Download it from www.videolan.org if it's not already installed.)
- 2. Go to Media > Convert/Save
- 3. Click on "Add"

 Select the video file from your iPhone.
- 4. Click on "Convert/Save" again.
- 5. **Under "Profile"**, choose one of the following:
 - Video H.264 + MP3 (MP4) → Best compatibility
 - Video for YouTube HD → Also works well for laptops
- 6. Click on "Browse"

Choose where to save the new video and give it a name (make sure it ends with .mp4).

7. Click "Start"

VLC will convert the video—this may take a few minutes depending on the file size.

Best Output Format for Easy Playback

For customers who aren't tech-savvy, we recommend:

• MP4 (H.264 + MP3)

This format works on nearly all devices without any additional software or codecs.

💡 Bonus Tips:

- If you face playback issues even after conversion, try using **VLC Player** on your laptop—it supports nearly all video types.
- For Linux users, ensure you have the **restricted codecs** installed (like ubuntu-restricted-extras or equivalent).
